- Review Approach to Recognize Volunteers






## Accomplishments: Professional Development

- Since March 2012, three ESS sessions were delivered to about 60 participants: Average satisfaction rate: 93%
- Two professional development events (course on performance measurement; course on multiple methods): Average satisfaction rates of 95% and 96%
- ALE this year: new professional development stream in program



#### Feedback from Course Participants (Averages for ESS, Performance Measurement Course, Mixed Methods Course)




#### Accomplishments: Networking

- Two breakfast sessions were offered (including this one)
  - "Tackling the Contribution Challenge: the Latest Thinking" October 22, 2012 (81 participants)
- One networking event in December for CES members (Approximately 50 participants)
- Annual Learning Event in February (138 participants; about half had more than 7 years of experience)







#### Accomplishments: Other

- Most communications now handled by volunteers, including text, mail-outs and translation.
- New Website: in development. Target for completion: July 2013
- Training needs assessment: ongoing. Target for completion: May 2013
- Provided feedback to PWGSC about TSPS
- Preliminary work for 2014 conference
- Prepared and sent nominations to CES national for two awards (contribution to CES, contribution to evaluation)
